3. Knockout Competitions

Turnout was good, with the exception of division 3. Please encourage your team to support the end of season knockouts.

It was put to the floor that the end of season knockout be a single draw played over two boards rather than the current draw per board.

Pros

Cons

Players stand more chance of being drawn against their own team mates
Could end up playing on boards of differing quality (lighting, position etc)

All present with one exception voted **FOR** a single draw

4. Postponements

Teams were reminded to avoid postponements at all costs.

5. Knockout Cup Draw

The committee had been made aware that some teams were not happy that the lower positioned team was always given home advantage in the knockout cup and consolation cup draws. It was put to the floor that the home advantage be as drawn with the exception of fixture clashes (pubs with more than one team) in that event the first drawn pairing would take precedence. A total Majority were **FOR** the change.

6. Tendering Challenge

Maldon won the Tendering Challenge 16-11 this year, full results of each of the games can be found on the website. Next year the match will be at Tendering and the venue and date will be decided at the beginning of the Summer 2018 season.

7. Committee Resignation and Re-election
