Costs for running the league have increased (Trophy costs, replacing missing trophies, Darts boards for Finals night) and therefore there is a need to increase the league fees to £60 for next season.

For various reasons there are several missing trophies from Division 3 from prior covid. The floor was asked if anyone was willing to sponsor a trophy to replace them and Troy Hogg and Pete Mead have both offered to sponsor a Trophy (via their companies) so the committee are very grateful for the offer and a quote and order will be sorted out as soon as we can. We will now have to also limit the number of trophies per team to 8, if any additional trophies are required, we can order them for an additional £10 per trophy.

3. Tendring Challenge

No date has yet been agreed with Tendring to complete this challenge, but we are due to host. The venue is also yet to be decided, so keep an eye on the website for more information

4. Knockout Cup – Consolation Cup

It was proposed that the final of the knockout cup be played over two legs (home and away) nobody opposed to this suggested. The rules have been updated to reflect this, and the winner will be the most legs scored over 36 legs – should there be a tie after 36 legs, then the captain will choose a player from their side to play a best of 3

5. End of Season Competitions

Splitting between the competition venues was much better last season, with only Div2 singles running late. Still a slightly lower turn out for division 3. A reminder that players must be present in the venue to be entered into the draw. Also, a reminder that if you know you are unable to make the finals night then you should not enter the preliminary competitions.

6. Committee

The existing committee stood down. All members were willing to stand, and the floor voted unanimously to re-elect all members to their existing positions.

In addition, there was only one volunteer for the vacant committee position – Stuart Parkes from Hardy's Bar. Unfortunately, Stuart was unable to make the AGM, but he was proposed by Dave Chapman from Swan City and seconded by Shaun Frostick from the Borough Arms. There were no objections from the floor. The Committee welcomes Stuart as its new member.
